

Group Sales Policies and Procedures

GROUP SALES POLICIES

- Every attendee must have a ticket, including babies and toddlers. Group tickets are the same price for adults and children.
- Prices are inclusive of sales tax and facility fees. A one-time \$10 group fee will be applied to the order.
- All seating in each price level is subject to availability. Please let us know if you have specific seating requests.
- Please note that ticket pricing is subject to change until seats are secured with either a full payment or a 10% deposit.

RESERVING GROUP TICKETS

To reserve your group seats, you may either:

- Pay for your group tickets in full,
 OR
- Hold a block of seats by placing a 10% non-refundable deposit on the total group order.
 - This method is recommended if you are unsure of your exact headcount or need time to collect payment from group members but want to secure best available seating.
 - Deposits will always count towards the overall balance.
 - Final headcount and payment will then be due 30 days prior to your selected performance. Upon making your final payment, you may adjust your group headcount by releasing or adding seats (subject to availability).
 - Please note that any held, unpaid seats will be released if your order is not paid in full on the due date.

PLACING YOUR GROUP ORDER

- All group orders must be placed through Atlanta Ballet Group Sales before arriving at the theatre. Group tickets cannot be purchased at the Cobb Energy Centre box office.
- All sales are final. No refunds or exchanges will be offered unless a performance is canceled or rescheduled.
- Payment Methods: Credit/debit card information can be taken over the phone or you may mail a check. Atlanta Ballet does not accept cash payments.
- Ticket Delivery: Once your group order is paid in full, tickets can be mailed, emailed as print-at-home tickets, or picked up at Cobb Energy Centre's Will Call up to two hours prior to the performance.
